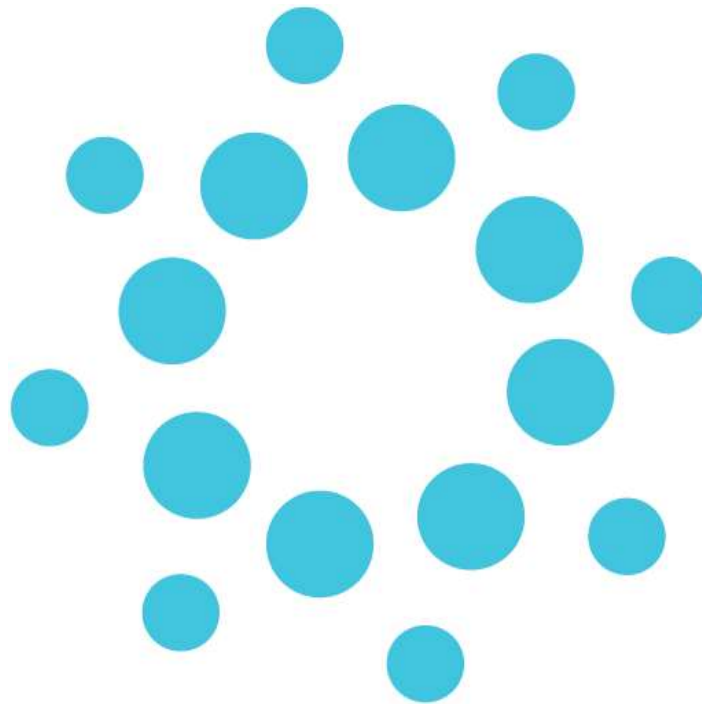

Introduction

These Release Notes provide an overview of the enhancements made within Medtech32 Version 22.7 Build 5243 to support the new NIR schedules for human papilloma virus (HPV) vaccine [Gardasil 9] and the funding changes will come into effect from 1 January 2017.

Changes to the National Immunisation Schedule – HPV Vaccine

The Ministry of Health has confirmed the following changes to the National Immunisation Schedule, effective from 1 January 2017.

- The quadrivalent human papilloma virus (HPV) vaccine [Gardasil] will be replaced with the 9-valent HPV vaccine [Gardasil 9].
- The 9-valent HPV vaccine will be administered as two doses for patients aged < 15 years and as three doses for patients aged ≥ 15 years.
- Funding for HPV vaccination has been extended to male patients aged 9–26 years.

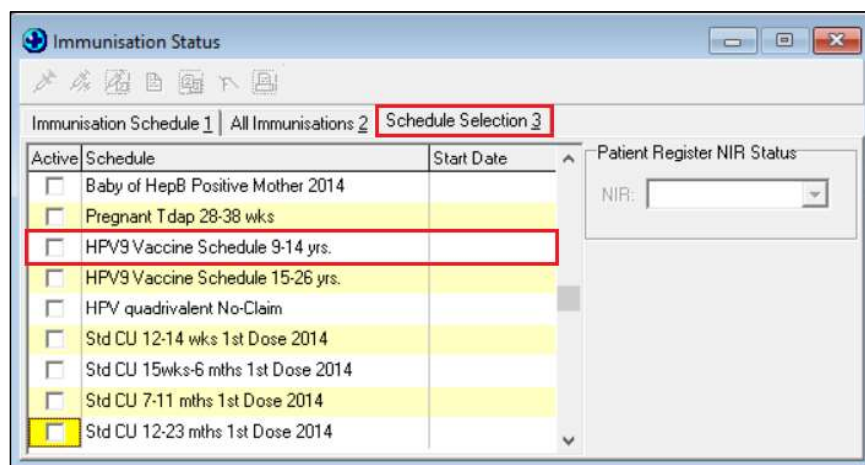


The following changes have been made to the Immunisation module at the direction of the Ministry of Health.

New HPV9 Schedule for Patients Aged 9–14 Years

A new HPV9 Vaccine Schedule for patients aged 9–14 years is available under the **Schedule Selection** tab.




Under this HPV9 vaccine schedule, patients aged < 15 years will receive two doses at 0 and 6 months. If a patient received their first dose at age < 15 years and their second dose at age ≥ 15 years, they will require a third dose to complete the course. The second and third doses should be administered 6 and 10 months after the first dose, respectively.


For patients who received two doses before the age of 15 years, the outcome of the third dose will be automatically completed with '**Closed Not Required**'.







There are two categories of high-risk patients eligible for funded HPV9 vaccines:

- **Transplant Patients** of any age will receive three doses of the vaccine
- **Postchemotherapy Patients** aged < 27 years, and who have already received their three doses of scheduled HPV vaccine, will receive an additional dose of HPV9 vaccine.

Amount Column not Printing on Banking List

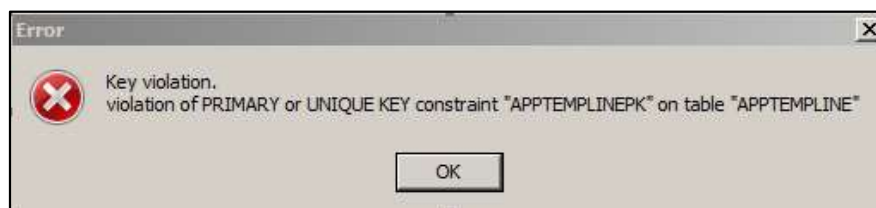
